SENIOR DIPLOMA IN GERMAN

OBJECTIVES: To improve and consolidate the students basic knowledge and communicative skills.

DURATION: 4 Months

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Junior Diploma in German with a minimum of 50%, or candidates with German as a second language at the undergraduate level with a minimum of 50% in the language, or candidates with an equivalent qualification will be requested to take an entrance examination.

JOB POTENTIAL:

- A person with a Senior Diploma would be in a position to teach the language to beginners fairly effectively.
- The course also equips the person to undertake job works in translation with the help of a dictionary.
- The Senior Diploma student would be in a position to conduct a good conversation in German, thus enabling him/her to secure a job in a firm/company with German collaboration.

MODE: Campus Mode: The classes for this course would be conducted at the University College of Arts and Social Science.

COURSE CONTENT

- Consolidation of basic grammar, Konjunktiv II
- Participial constructions, paraphrasing the passive voice
- Plusperfect, verbs governing cases
- Subordinate clauses
- Nouns with suffixes
- Infinitive sentences, consecutive clauses
- Causative sentences

- Subjunctive indirect speech
- Passive voice *Vorgangs und Zustandspassiv*
- Prepositions with the genitive case
- Future tense
