About the Workshop

The Department of Political Science, University College of Arts and Social Sciences , Osmania University is Organizing a Three days workshop to faculty members for orientation on new papers in the Political Science discipline from 28^{th} , 29^{th} & 30^{th} August 2019 sponsored by TSCHE .

As per the guidelines of the Telangana State Council for Higher Education (TSCHE). The following new papers with credits (under CBCS system) have been introduced at the Under Graduate level from 2019-20 onwards (applicable to all the Telangana State Universities. The papers include the core papers, Skill Enhanced courses & General Elective courses such as 1) Understanding Political Theory, 2) Western Political Thought, 3) Indian Political Thought, 4) Psephology and Public Opinion, 5) Human Rights, 6) Constitution and Politics of India, 7) Legislative Practices and procedures 8) Laws, Duties and Rights of Citizens 9) Political of Development, 10) International Relations 11) Government & Politics in Telangana 12,) Contemporary Political Theory in B.A. Regular course.

New programmes such as B.A. Public Policy & BA International studies have been introduced in the Gurukulas & Residential Colleges.

BA Honours in Political Science has been taken has a prestigious initiative. As the syllabi is new and includes new papers such Ex: Media & Democracy, Federal Politics, Political journalism, Western Political Thought, State Politics, Ethics & Morality etc. As the faculty needs to the oriented towards the aim & objectives of the new papers.

As all the above papers have been introduced from academic year 2019-20 onwards, the faculty members are facing difficulties in terms of the approaches and the reference material for effective teaching of the above papers. In this above back drop, the Department of the Political Science, Osmania University would like to take an initiative to conduct a series of orientation workshops by inviting the subject experts to impart an orientation to the faculty members on effective teaching of the above papers at the UG level including BA Public Policy and International Relations, SEC, GE in general and BA Honorsim particular in Telangana State. The commencement of the inaugural session was done by the Co-Convenor, Dr. V. Srilatha BoS Chairman , addressing the Dignitaries and faculty participants, welcoming and giving a brief of the three-day workshop, This was followed by the address of the President and Convener of the session Dr. R Chandru, Head , Dept. of Political Science , welcomed the Chief Guests, Prof. R. Each sessions was ninty minutes duration of which about an hour is allotted to lecture cum intersection and the rest of the time is allotted to Q7A During each session participants actively participated, raised a number of questions to related to the topic and sought clarifications from the resources persons, most of the sessions exceeded the allotted time. The workshop was attended by 80 participants.
