Located at Narayanpet district of Krishna mandal, Mudumal village. This educational field visit for the MA (Previous and Final) students under the guidance of Dr. D Jayasree, to the Mudumal Menhirs, located in Narayanpet district. This visit aims to provide students with direct exposure to prehistoric archaeological sites, enriching their understanding of megalithic cultures in the Deccan region and the site expert prof. K P Rao he shared his thoughtful observations and experiences guided many things like how to take photographs in the field, how to dig and find out the object sir has shared astronomical knowledge ethnographically to the students. The Mudumal Menhirs are a significant megalithic burial site, gaining scholarly attention for their historical and cultural importance. one of the rare surviving examples of prehistoric funerary architecture in Telangana these Menhirs offer critical insights into the social and ritual practices of the early Iron Age communities in South India. I believe that this visit gave the students greatly enhance the academic learning experience of our postgraduate students and complement their classroom studies with field experience.</p>
